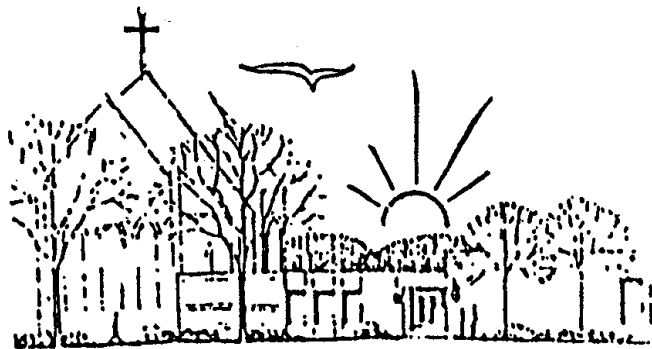


Thanks be to God for all who help in so many countless, quiet and even anonymous ways to make our Lent to Easter Season, as well as the entire liturgical year, so wonderful.
