The day's events offer: an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation; a full Rosary with all 20 Mysteries said while walking the beautiful grounds; an outdoor Mass with Bishop John Folda of Fargo as the Main Celebrant at 5:00 pm; a picnic style meal (free-will offering) to finish the day and send pilgrims home. Pilgrims are encouraged to bring their intentions to write down and be left for the Carmelite Nuns to pray for, and also any garden/farm produce you want to offer in thanksgiving of a bountiful harvest and if desired, leave for the Carmelites. The Carmelite Nuns are a cloistered order and rely totally on donations for their existence. Pilgrims are also encouraged to bring a lawn chair if they want to sit in the shade, a hat or sun bonnet, extra water and sun screen if it is a sunny day.
