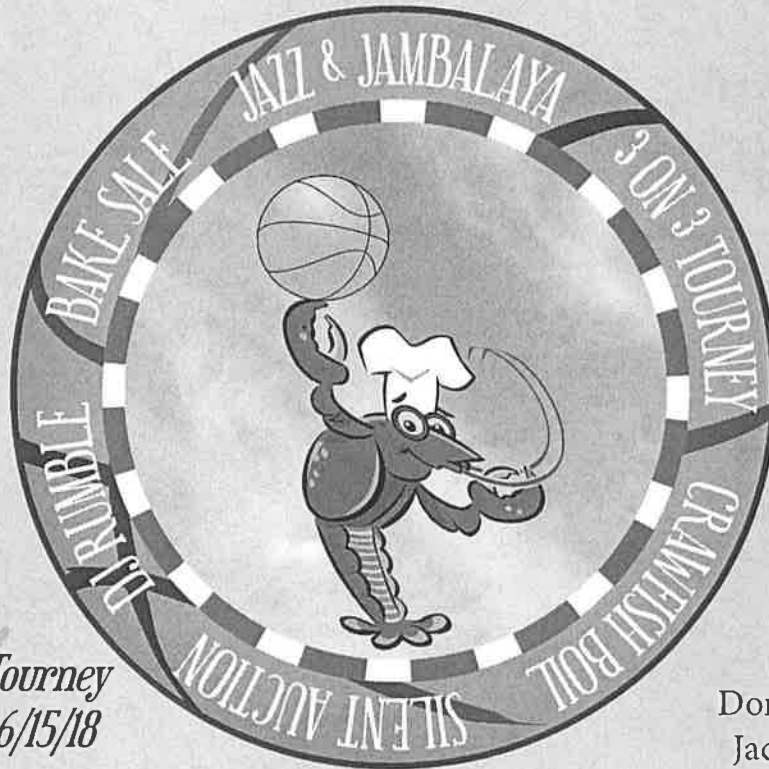

On Friday, January 12, 2018 Jacob was warming up for a basketball game in Devils Lake, ND. When he came down on his leg, his femur bone broke. It was due to a unknown tumor that had been in his thigh. Jacob was flown from Grand Forks to the U of M Children's Hospital in Minneapolis. On Monday, January 15, 2018 Jacob had surgery to place a pin in his leg to keep the broken bone separated as it was causing him a lot of pain. While in surgery, the doctors took a biopsy to see what type of cancer mass or tumor it was, so to get a better diagnoses and treatment plan. They learned it was a cancerous osteosarcoma tumor. Jacob started his 1st round of chemo on February 10th. After further testing, March 31st, Jacob and his family were told he would lose his leg. After careful consideration and weighing all options, April 2nd, Jacob's leg was amputated above the knee. April 17th, Jacob started his 2nd round of chemo. Jacob is currently healing at home, but will endure many trips back to Minneapolis. He and his family have a long road ahead of them adjusting to their new lifestyle.
